

Guidelines on the PCCC Accreditation System

Calculation of Continuing Education Unit (CEU) is based on the calendar year. The guidelines regarding PCCC's CEU accreditation system are as follows:

(A) CE Seminars, Workshops and Educational Conferences

- PCCC organises approximately 10 CE seminars each year. Enrolled pharmacists can attend the seminars free of charge, non-members need to pay \$50 per lecture
- PCCC also grants CEU to non-PCCC organised programs, provided that the program is pharmacy practice related and prior approval from PCCC is required

Program	CEU
PCCC Seminar (non-conference)	2 CEU per hour
Hong Kong Pharmacy Conference: <3hours	2 CEU per hour
One day (≥3 hours)	6 CEU per day
Whole conference	10 CEU per conference
Non-PCCC seminar/workshop/conference	2 CEU per topic (max. 6 CEU per program)
Speakers for the above CE programmes	6 CEU per seminar hour or per topic

(B) PCCC CE Articles

- A separate enrollment for CE articles will be called for at the beginning of each year
- Members enrolled to receiving CE articles can also receive CEU by completing the answer sheet of self-study CE articles selected by PCCC
- The passing mark for each CE article is 60%
- Answer sheet(s) need to be returned by mail to PCCC within 2 months in order to receive credit. The deadline for submission will be marked on the answer sheet(s)

Completing & passing article questions	2 CEU per article
Authors of an approved CE article:	
Primary author	6 CEU per article
Other co-authors of the same CE article	4 CEU per article

(C) Certificates of Achievement

- CE certificates will be issued to registered pharmacists completing at least 20 CEU per year as an appreciation of their efforts
- The certificates are distributed in February/March each year
